I feel very fortunate to be born on that beautiful island and to have a father from Jamaica and mother from Australia. I can't run as fast as Usain Bolt or bowl as fast as some of her famous West Indian cricketers but I do love going to the beach and playing reggae music.

My parents were missionaries and I grew up and did my schooling in South Korea and England. I have one sister named Kylie and together we were always introduced overseas as "Jason and Kylie from Australia" like the famous Neighbours actors. (later we even moved back to Australia into "Ramsey Street" in Toowoomba)

From a young age I learned the incredible value of

faith in the Lord Jesus Christ. This has had the greatest impact on my life and I can testify that Jesus has brought me life more abundantly. My favourite verse as a child was John 3:16 which says that "God so loves the world that He gave His only begotten son..." My faith was formed each Sunday in Sunday School and each weekday around the dinner table as my parents would lead prayers and share Bible stories.
